How will Doodle Den help me as a parent/carer?

You will get information on different ways to support your child's reading and writing. You will also learn how to use the library services, including their computers, DVDs, and books!

How will we know it works?

Doodle Den has been carefully checked by a research team from Belfast. We are always looking at what we do and how we do it. We collect information every year on the children's progress to ensure we know that Doodle Den is helping children.

The Results:

- Doodle Den has made improvements in the children's literacy
- Children did better in word choice, sentence structure and word recognition
- There was an increase in family library time and home reading
- The evidence suggests that the children's behaviour improved
- Teacher's reports showed an improvement in the children's literacy which meant their expectations of the children increased
