



Our school is delighted to introduce Doodle Families, a new literacy programme for children in First Class and their parents/carers. Doodle Families aims to help children and parents/carers to have fun and find ways to make sure that reading and writing skills develop really well.

What would my child do?

Children who take part in Doodle Families will have a one-hour programme either after school or during school time for eight weeks. For this hour your child will be doing fun learning activities such as games, arts and crafts and fun interactive reading activities.

What do I have to do?

Because parents/carers are so important to how children learn, we will have a one-hour session every week for eight weeks, just for you. This will happen every week, for eight weeks. This will take place during school hours.

The hour will be with a staff member from the school, and it will also be fun, with the aim of helping you to help your child. You will learn different ways to support your child with their literacy with fun tips and ideas on how to do this.

What do I need to do now?

If you and your child would like to take part in Doodle Families, talk to your class teacher, the Home School Community liaison or SCP staff, and they will give you more information and support you to register. We would love you to be involved.
